

Deep Run Lacrosse Parents Code of Conduct 2009

Deep Run Valley Sports Association has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their child participating in our program.

Please check each box after you have reviewed:

- I will not force my child to participate in sports and remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for kids, not adults
- I will be respectful and positive to all players, coaches, officials, and other spectators
- I will never, under any circumstance, use abusive or foul language towards any player, official, coach, or other spectators
- If I have concerns about players, coaches or parents, I will follow the correct sequence to deal with my concerns. I will contact the head coach first, then Chris Fechter—Lacrosse Commissioner, then the Lacrosse Board of Directors. If my concern is still not resolved, I will contact the Deep Run Board of Directors.
- I will make every effort to get my child to practices, games or team functions promptly to help promote the concept of team unity and respect for other peoples time
- I will remain on the opposite side of the field during games, and will cheer positively for all players
- I will inform my child's coach of any medical condition my child may have
- I will offer my services for any projects the lacrosse program may need
- I will reinforce with my child that the basic fundamentals of lacrosse are the most important aspect in becoming the best lacrosse player my child can be
- I will refrain from coaching my child during practices or games and will emphasize the importance of being respectful and paying attention to the coaches
- I will remember that everyone involved is volunteering their time to create the most positive, fun learning experience possible

I understand that if I fail to abide by the above Deep Run Lacrosse Parents Code of Conduct, or any other rules that may apply, that I may be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to:

- Verbal warning from officials, coaches, or Deep Run
- Written warning
- Game suspension or forfeit with written report kept on file at Deep Run
- Parental season suspension
