1. What is Deep Run's Everybody Hits Program?

Everybody Hits is a Softball-Baseball Program for Special Needs Kids sponsored by the Deep Run Valley Sports Association. The program is noncompetitive with the emphasis on fun and teaching the basic skills of the game!

2. When and where do we sign up for the Everybody Hits program?

On-line registration takes place starting in early March at www.drvs.org. In person registration will also be held on several days at the Deep Run Clubhouse. Please check our website for dates and times.

3. What is the age range for the program?

The program is open to all Special Needs kids, ages 6-16.

4. When and where is the program held?

The 2010 Everybody Hits program will be held at the Deep Run Complex, Field #2, on the following Sundays from 1:00 to 2:00 PM: April 11th, 18th, 25th and May 2nd and 9th (with a raindate of May 16th).

5. What is the cost to participate in Everybody Hits?

There is no cost to participate in the program.

6. Who runs the program?

The program will be run by Deep Run softball and players.

7. What do I need to provide my child?

Players can bring a glove, or one will be provided. All other equipment will be provided, as well.
